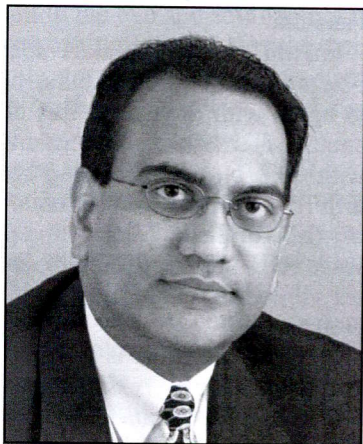


Dr. Rakesh Mangal
